Thank you for your continued support. We continue to meet the needs of those in the Rutland area with food hampers. Another function of our organization that your support enables is InVincible Housing, a special project of the Okanagan Valley Particular Council of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVP). More and more we see that food shortage and other hardships are a function of rental costs, often taking 60%, 70% or even a larger percentage of the household's income. Currently InVincible housing provides up to \$450 in rent assistance once a year to people struggling with rent issues. So far in 2020, 40 households were helped - about a quarter of those in the Rutland area.

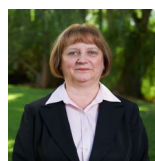
